

2019 – LIVESTOCK PROJECT EDUCATIONAL POLICIES

- Exhibitors must complete two educational requirements approved by the Sale Committee in order to sell their animals at the Junior Livestock Auction.
- Programs attended must be between the dates of September 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019.
- If you are considering an educational not listed in the handbook to meet your requirements, contact the UW-Extension Office or Chair of the Meat Animal Sale Committee before attending the program for approval.

CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATIONAL PARTICIPATION:

- Youth attending an educational program must obtain a signature on the Certificate of Educational Participation of someone organizing or conducting the educational program.
- Certificates of Educational Participation showing evidence of completing the educational programs must be at the Extension Office by June 30 or exhibitors will not be allowed to sell.
- It is your responsibility to obtain the appropriate signature(s). If you have questions, need more certificates, or lose a signed certificate please contact the UW-Extension Office ahead of the deadline.

The following items are provided as examples of approved programs.

- Local and regional educational activities listed on the educational calendar located at <https://washington.uwex.edu/agriculture/youth-livestock/>.
- Approved area, district, state or national livestock show or breed organization activity.
- Programs such as World Beef Expo, Sheep & Wool Festival, and World Dairy Expo.
- One of the two programs can be in the dairy project area.
- Completed feeding plan that you received at weigh-in, completed and returned before the due date, for only one species. These are due one month after registration.
- Helping the sales committee as needed.

PROGRAMS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EDUCATIONAL CREDIT:

Breakfast on the Farm, Washington County Fair or Carcass Show, State Fair, 4-H project meeting, school classroom instruction, August Animal Science meeting, Registration for Beef, Sheep or Swine.

It is your responsibility:

To report at least two approved programs you have attended, or you will not be allowed to sell your animal at the sale. You are encouraged to deliver the certificates any time during the year ahead of the June 30 deadline.
