Any exhibitor not able to make the registration date for their animals must make arrangements with the registration committee ahead of time to schedule an alternate time.

- June 30**      A minimum of two Certificates of Educational Participation are Due - MUST be returned to UW-Extension Office, P.O. Box 2003, West Bend 53095-2003. You are encouraged to turn in well ahead of this deadline. Go to: <https://washington.uwex.edu/agriculture/youth-livestock> for educational opportunities.
- June 28**      County Fair entries due - all fair entries are now submitted on-line and MUST be in before the last business day in Friday, June 28. Your club may collect and organize their own entries with earlier deadlines, or you may need to submit entries yourself on-line. Find out if you need to work with your group or if you are personally responsible.
- July 23-28**    Washington County Fair: All animals brought to the fair MUST be healthy and MUST be identified with 2 tags (health papers swine) before unloading. Superintendents have the authority to keep animals from being unloaded. A decision by the fair vet on duty (no other) to remove animals from the fairgrounds is binding and non-negotiable and removal compliance is required within one hour of the decision.

## FAIR WEIGH-IN SCHEDULE

- July 23**      **Fair weigh-in:** All animals must be in place Tuesday between 10 a.m. and 12:30 p. m. Lambs will be weighed in pen by pen starting at 1:00pm, swine will be weighed in pen by pen immediately following lambs. No free weigh-ins. Beef will be weighed in starting at 1:00 pm and order will be at superintendent's discretion. PLEASE NOTE: Animals will not be allowed to unload before 10:00 am. Consignment I Antibiotic I Code of Conduct sheet and other required paperwork should be turned in by the final weigh-in.
